CIVIL (Insurance, Banking, Construction & Government) Executive Summary (1 minute read)

Friday v Minister for Primary Industry and Resources (FCA) - native title - leases - mining - applicants sought to prevent first respondent from granting 'mineral lease application' - challenges to grant of mineral lease application did not have merit - application dismissed (I B C G)

Australia and New Zealand Banking Group Limited v James (No 2) (FCA) - privilege - corporations - 'legal advice privilege' - respondent sought production of 'unredacted copy of' document ("Project Spirit – Receivership planning meeting, 8 August 2013") - applicant claimed privilege over 'redacted portion of' the document - privilege claim upheld (I B C G)

In the matter of A.C.N. 004 410 833 Limited (formerly Arrium Limited) (In Liquidation) (NSWSC) - corporations - liquidators sought orders approving entry into 'Settlement Deed' concerning proceedings ("Insolvent Trading Proceedings"), order they were justified to give effect to Settlement Deed and orders under *Court Suppression and Non-Publication Orders Act 2010* (NSW) - orders granted (B)

Ryan v Disler (VSC) - judicial review - plaintiff sought judicial review of opinion of Medical Panel opinion im which Panel answered questions as to whether plaintiff was injured in course of employment - proceeding dismissed (I B C G)

The President of the Legislative Council of Western Australia v Corruption and Crime



Commission [No 2] (WASC) - parliamentary privilege - proceedings concerning whether exercise by Corruption and Crime Commission (CCC) of 'power to obtain and examine documents' was, when concerning documents relating to Parliament's proceedings, 'inconsistent with parliamentary privilege' - receipt of 'documents and other items' on basis of 'valid determination of privilege' not valid - CCC lacked power to require privileged documents' production - declarations to be made. (I B C G)
